Keeping Ladders & Tools Secure in the Shed

Don't leave ladders or tools lying around in your garden – burglars could use these to break into your home, so store them securely in a shed or outbuilding. For added protection, use ground/wall anchors, padlocks, cables and chains to secure expensive items in your shed.

Less than 5% of stolen bikes are returned

If you've got a bike, secure it in a shed or garage with a solid secure approved cycle lock – statistics show that less than 5% of bikes stolen in the UK are ever returned. **LOCK IT OR LOSE IT!**



Use an alarm

Protect valuable items stored in a shed or outbuilding using a battery-powered stand-alone alarm.

Don't leave valuables in your vehicle

Trades people in particular should never leave tools in their vans as statistics show UK tradespeople have lost £75million from theft of tools since 2008. You may want to consider adding additional security to your van - see Sold Secure for details for approved vehicle security products.
